POSTER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstracts must be sent to the **INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON PARTICIPATORY HEALTH RESEARCH**, until 15-01-2019, 23:59 hours, through the on-line submission form, available at: www.esenf.pt

1. Abstract submission - poster

Abstracts must not exceed 350 words (excluding title, authors, affiliation, contacts and references); letter type “Times New Roman” at 11 points and 1.5 line spacing.

1.1 Writing the abstract (Portuguese or English: maximum 350 words)

- Authors [Name, surname; Name, surname];
- Affiliation [Institution + Professional category]
- E-mail contact(s)
- Organizing text:
 - Title
 - Introduction and Objectives
 - Methodology (participants, instruments and procedures)
 - Results and Discussion

NOTE: It is possible to submit non-completed studies. In this case, the Expected Outcomes must be referred and data collection strategies must be described

- Conclusions
- Keywords in Portuguese and English: maximum 4, separated by semicolon
- References according to APA style, 6^{ed}

1.2. Topics

- People and families living with chronic illness
- Reorganizing health services with the participation of people and families
- Methodologies of participatory health research

2. Submission (general information – poster)

Posters must be original and not been considered for presentation elsewhere

- 2.1. Authors will be informed of poster acceptance by e-mail, until **30-11-2018**.

2.2. To submit the poster proposal, in Portuguese or English language, the author must fill out the submission form available in the “Submission” tab.

2.3. The first author must be registered at the Conference, so full registration must be completed until **15.12.2018**.

2.4. Posters assessment is the responsibility of the Conference Scientific Committee with no decision appeal.

3. General information

3.1. For each presentation, a certificate will be issued including the names of all authors.

3.2. Each registered participant is authorized to submit a maximum of 2 posters, listed as the first author.

3.3. There will be no discussion of posters, however the authors should remain next to posters during the coffee-break and/or provide printed A4 copies to be distributed.

3.4. Poster printing is the author’s responsibility

3.5. The best poster will be awarded with a prize.

4. Poster formatting

Poster design:

4.1. Presented on paper or specific fabric format;

4.2. Vertical alignment;

- Dimensions: 80x100;
- Posters will be put out on display at 9:00 hours on the 4th January 2019.

5. Other information

Participants are encouraged to submit posters to the **INTERNATIONAL COURSE IN PARTICIPATORY HEALTH RESEARCH**, relating to projects to be included in participatory action-research. In this case, keywords must include the term ‘participatory action-research’ and the target population/group.
